Meet Amy Fowler. Since 2014, Amy has served as an advocate for ten children. From school visits to birthday parties to Christmas celebrations, Amy has been a constant presence in these children's lives for over a decade. Follow her journey below.

2014 Amy attends Light of Hope fundraiser and learns about the impact of child advocacy.

2015 Amy is sworn in and accepts her first case as a child advocate, a 15-year-old girl H*.

Amy accepts a second case with 3-year-old B.

Things move fast for B — she is adopted after just six months in foster care!



Amy takes her third case: a 5-year-old child named Rex. Rex and his sister (age 3) enter foster care.

2017

Rex's sister is adopted! But that means Rex loses daily contact with his only sibling. Amy commits to maintaining their connection.

Amy accepts her 4th case with three siblings— R, E, and L — ages 5, 3, and 1.

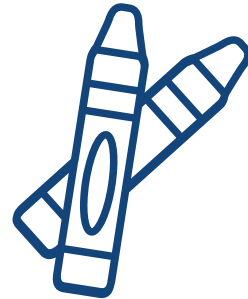
Amy accepts her fifth case with a 9-year-old child, A.

2018

With Amy's support, H attends Saturday school and completes her studies just in time for graduation. After three years in foster care, H is now able to live on her own.



Through 25 foster placements, most of them outside of NWA, Amy continues to visit Rex and A — always with art supplies and self-care items in hand.



2020-2022

Now at 14 years old, A must spend another holiday season in a facility. Amy makes it a special time by showing up to make gingerbread houses, watch movies and open gifts.

After six years in foster care, A is adopted!

Rex celebrates his 14th birthday. Amy is there celebrating with him.

Amy accepts her 6th case, with K and K — ages 15 and 10.



After 10 years with Amy by his side, Rex is finally adopted. Time truly can change everything!

After about one year in foster care, K and K's are in the process of being reunited with their father. Amy continues to advocate for their stability and future.
